




5 Cell Phone Tips

Setting Age Restrictions




Tap Settings > General > Restrictions. Scroll down and tap Restrictions, then tap Enable Restrictions.

Create a Restrictions passcode. You need your Restrictions passcode to change your settings or to turn off Restrictions.


Privacy Settings

Disable GPS features on phone and always check the privacy setting after each update




Social Media

- Know that anything you post online can be hard to take back and can be shared and used in ways you didn't intend.




